In Oregon, visit <u>Oregon.gov</u>. In Nevada, visit the state's <u>Health Response</u> resource page. California residents can find details on the state's <u>Care in Senior Living</u> website.

3. Does the staff excel at senior clinical care?

First, review the facility's **CMS rating**. Then, ask if rehab and clinical services are readily available onsite.

4. What should I do to prepare my loved one for their stay?

Find out what they can <u>bring from home</u>. The best post hospital care facilities understand their patients' desire to have familiar items nearby.
